TOP SCHEDULE/CLASS LEVEL QUESTIONS

Below are some of the frequently asked questions concerning PEDC dance levels and classes.

PEDC LEVEL DESCRIPTION

18 Months to 5 Year Old Levels

- Mom & Me: Beginner class for ages 18 months to 2. Mom or dad participates in class with their child
- Creative Movement 1: Basic Pre-Dance Class for ages 2 1/2 to 3
- 3/4 Yr Old Acrobatics/Hip Hop Combo: Pre-Acrobatics/ Hip Hop class for 3&4 yr olds.
- Creative Movement 2: Basic Pre-Dance Class for ages 3 to 4
- 4/5 Yr Old Ballet/Tap Combo 1: Introduction to Ballet and Tap for 4 & 5 yr olds
- 4/5 Yr Old Ballet/Tap Combo 2: Ballet and Tap for 4 & 5 yr olds that have taken Combo 1
- Hip Hop/ Hip Hop & Acrobatics Combo / Cheer Dance: Beginner classes for 4 & 5 yr olds
- Pre-Jazz: Beginner Jazz class for 5 yr old

6-7 Year Old Level

- Primary Level Classes: Classes of Ballet, Tap, Jazz & Hip Hop. Introduction to each discipline of dance.

7-10 Year Old Beginner Level

- Intro Level Classes: Hour classes of Ballet, Tap, Jazz & Hip Hop. Beginner level introduction to dance.

Additional Level Descriptions

Class Level Placement By Director/ Teacher

- Elementary Level Classes: 2 + years of dance experience typical in the class chosen. Typically ages 8 & up.
- Level 1 Classes: 3 + years of dance experience typical in the class chosen. Pre-Req: Elementary Level
- Level 2 Classes: 4 + years of dance experience typical in the class chosen. Pre-Req: Elementary/ Level 1
- Level 3 Classes : 5 + years of dance experience typical in the class chosen. Pre-Req: Level 1/2
- Level 4/5/Advanced Classes: 5 + years of dance experience typical in the class chosen. Pre-Req: Level 1/2/3

Teen/Adult Classes

- Teen/Adult Level Classes: Includes hour classes of Ballet, Tap, Jazz & Hip Hop. Advanced Beginner level introduction to dance.
- Adult Fitness Classes: PEDC offers Hip Hop fitness, Jazz Fitness classes for adults. Great way to get in shape.

TOP QUESTIONS

Q: How do I know what level to place my child?

A: Levels are determined not only by age but most importantly by ability. PEDC staff has a level syllabus to determine the requirements for each level of classes. Listed above is a basic placement guide. Please ask the director or teacher for recommendations.

Q: Does my child move to the next level automatically every year?

A: Unlike school, your child may stay in the same level for more than 1 year. It is important as a parent that you remember that all children learn dance at a different pace. You should NEVER compare your child to other children.

Q: How do I know that my child is in the correct level?

A: During the first month of class teachers are evaluating your child's ability in class. PEDC will move students to a different level if needed so that your child receives the best dance education.
